



Mr. Abbassi's Talk (Part II)

-Opening Prayer

The question of justice and spiritual/religious tales is in regard to injustice, crime and debt, which pleads wisdom and dialogue to no end or avail.

When we look at the word justice, we notice that it rests in corporation of knowledge or wisdom the "self" (Nafs). When a society is capable of administering justice and incorporating wisdom in the self or nafs, there can be justice. Justice, truth and order have the same meaning in operation. The reason for lack of wisdom in the self is that "Insaf" or a natural justice or law is diluted in the country of Iran, inhibiting the incorporation of wisdom in the self.

"Answering questions" or in effect, accountability, is a division of justice and Insaf as insaf pertains to the Pluralistic society. Therefore, we have to be redeemable. The question is, "who do answer to?" We have to answer to God, religion, people and the government. We have to balance our books with regard to justice and insaf, which then can equate cultural dignity.

Answers to the law are important, because they encompass all. How can we escape answering to God? Or how do we justify our actions? In the kingdom of God, it is impossible to escape answering to God. As a Moslem, we cannot evade answering to the Book of Koran, because one of the doctrines of the religion is adherence to its tenets, among which is acceptance of the Koran as face-value. The Imam Ali spoke to God, asking, "how can I escape your justice?" The Koran is more of a factual/mathematical book with clear definitions of equality.

Accountability to the people is important, because if the servers of public interest do not fulfill their responsibilities, they may not be re-elected. For example, the representatives of the people in current Iranian government were using public funds to produce their own movie, and were opening private television stations abroad in lieu of representing the public. "From whose account are they drawing?"

Differing sects must be accountable to the government, especially because some of them are financially supported by the government to carry out their missions. Senator Sam Brownback spent \$53 million to advertise in thirteen Los Angeles television stations to act against the current Iranian regime. The same senator sponsored eight spies to work against the Iranian government.

Education and religion here get neutralized next to each other, because they are both answering to the law. The philosophical dilemma is that we are taught to believe that what is legal is good, and not what is good legal. This dilemma has not been defined or solved in our country. The proponents of freedom did not clear this liberalism-derived definition or statement of truth.

The government is spending 1,700,000,000 toomans on the opening ceremony of an airport, when the event could have been funded by 100,000 toomans. Naturally, the organizers do not sense that they are accountable to the law. Another injustice is the burning to ashes of the homeless, who had historically followed the prophet and for whom the prophet had acted. These homeless or (barefoot) who lost their lives were not backed by a government just as Ms. Zahra Kazemi was backed by the Canadian government.

In the student demonstration of 18th of Teer, 1978, when there was not one drop of blood shed, the governments in interest asked that the Minister of Defense get replaced. However, after the occurrence at Neishapoor with 400 deaths, there was no claim by any government. There is no difference in their blood. Liberal democracy states that if something is lawful, it is good. The Koran is representative of good, and they do not want to accept that, but they want to accept arbitrary law. This is the outcome of liberal politics, which is wrong in effect. They have problems, because they do not adhere to the Koran; they answer to the law. Looking at politicians, again they are accountable to the public as long as they get re-elected. They are not accountable to leadership. When the three economic powers, who are known as spiritual leaders, meet, it seems as if they are house-visiting for the New Year!

It's been shown that political stations can all be bought. They take down innocent trees, put their pictures on the paper and distribute them on every wall. If you cannot uphold justice, do not pay more for your admission to hell. Due to the mismanagement of the facilities, this country with incredible resources is starving. A 29 year old can buy the votes of the representatives of the Congress. That 1,700,000,000 has been approved if the leaders remain silent.

The Minister of Education and of the Nation has kept silent in regard to the sale of Iranian woman. If the leaders of the police force could imagine being answerable to God, they would resign immediately. There is no policing of each other, because they all work together in crime. One must expose the Mafia networks. Mismanagement and the disability of the ruling class has ruined the country. Due to the indiscretions related to the sale of the Shiite woman in The Arab Emirates, the operations, intelligence and cultural leaders should have been terminated in their positions. Dobai and The Emirates do not receive any reprimand.

The U.S. government is testing the public. They operate step by step and have realized that there is no gender pride left in the country. The U.S. tanks will be under way to Tehran, knowing that if they do not have gender pride or patriotism, they will not defend against an attack. Some of the leaders have ten different positions in government, therefore no wonder that they cannot control the country. They pass a law and subsequently agree that it is a "good law." They also believe that the Koran can be interpreted in many ways. A group of

uneducated people have spoken in congress and passed laws. They are too busy to protect the public servants, because they do not see each other as answerable.

Imam or Saint Hossein declared that the sword of Islam acts against your children, because of the poison of injustice flourishing beneath your skin. This is the time to act and not to talk. The furniture they sit on, the fancy cars their children drive, are all from "unkosher" funds. They have desensitized the defenses of conscience, and thus we have to doubt their adherence to The Koran. As The Koran states, "we have stamped their hearts, therefore their conscience should kill them." The Iranian government arrested a German man who had relations with a Shiite woman, but says nothing about the sale of Shiite women in The Emirates. Karbala came about because the unkosher bread had risen beneath their skins.

One cannot state that the Koran is good and therefore law. No, the Koran is not law. The gates of hell have opened to the leaders of the Islamic Republic. An entertainer who is seen only smoking and chewing gum in Congress has influence. Instead of taking care of the homeless, they want to entertain their sects and political parties. They take up sword against Hassan and Hossein, the descendents of the prophet, and they must believe that there are no consequences to their actions and no tomorrow for today's actions.

When Ernesto Chagara became the Minister of Finance in Castro's Cuba after the revolution, he accepted the famed Jean Paul Sartre at two o'clock in the morning for a meeting. He showed up showered and awake in military uniform, while the guards were half asleep with their guns in their lap. They asked him why so late? He answered, "one should not sleep no longer." This was an Argentinian who went to help Cuba and then to Bolivia where he was murdered by the U.S. government who set up guerilla warfare in that country. The Islamic leaders have to follow Chagara's suit.

We sleep easily, a luxury that came to no prophet. We are giving away what was given to us by our prophets, saints and martyrs. The mullahs of Iran, sleep so little, one should look at their full bellies for evidence! We are busy taking pictures of representatives smoking a pipe and putting them on websites. There is so much wasted time that the assistant to the Prime Minister, chats on his website all day. He is not capable of speaking logically about justice and equality. This assistant sits on multi-million dollar furniture and his children are part of the Cartel, whereas the children of the Prime Minister take the bus to study in Ghom. If you had courage, you would have replaced those cabinets. In terms of management, the organization of the Prime Minister is below zero. If you do not follow conscience and not waste the public's money and not sell the Shiite woman, we will all be in hell. All of your discretions are recorded under the name of spirituality and religion. The Commander of the Air Force should have plotted a military coup against The Emirates and the Commander of the Navy should not be able to sleep, planning and preventing their possible escape. In Najaf, the American soldier has brought the Moslem under his rule.

The people in Najaf and Ghom are living under fear and are not able to leave their homes, because of what goes on in the streets. If people do not

Speak up, that means that they have a vested interest in this. But what the government is doing should not be placed under Islamic Law. The standard of conduct is The Prophet and if you act against his conduct, you are wrong! Whatever is good is due to Koran and Islam and whatever is bad or wrong, you are responsible for. The law is wrong. You have to pay for your ways. Our law does not have roots in religion. We are defending Islam, because the Iranian leaders speak as if communicated from Islam; this is incorrect. You are taking advantage of your leadership positions. In this country, many people go to bed hungry. The associates of Khatami—have they ever endured hunger? People in leadership should fast regularly to sense how the poor and indigent are going through. Islam recommended you, the public. You should recommend Islam.

The leaders do not say their nightly prayers, because there is no spirituality to their nature. Pray and ask for forgiveness. The prophet in later days pled to God, “not to leave me alone.” How can you be without God? There is just a matter of time before Mecca is under foreign fire and siege.

Mr. Khatami, please read the Koran once again and pay attention to its verses. The leaders of government should not sleep at night, and if one Shiite woman is being sold as a slave, you have to answer and remain accountable. You have to live among people. The leaders of Iran do not walk on foot. They have been riding in Mercedes for twenty five years. We are not asking you to be saints. The foundation of your accountability should be The Koran and if you cannot read, refer to your spiritual leader. God will take away your bounty if you do not follow these spiritual principles. Our success earlier was due to the wake and prayers of the spiritual leaders. In all these matters. Myself as well as you are guilty. Amen.
